

## Troop 767 Information

### MISSION OF TROOP 767

The mission of Troop 767 is to prepare young people to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetimes by instilling in them the values of the Scout Oath and Law.

### CHARTER INFORMATION/LOCATION

Troop 767 is chartered by the Lutheran Church of Hope in Broomfield. The church is located at 1305 West 10<sup>th</sup> Street.

### GENERAL TROOP INFORMATION

The size of the Troop ranges between 70 and 85 Scouts, depending on the year. The Scouts are distributed among several patrols, consisting of between 7-14 boys each. These patrols are blended by age, which means that each patrol will have both older Scouts and younger Scouts. The older Scouts act as mentors for the younger Scouts.

The adult leadership of Troop 767 is active and well-trained. The Troop committee consists of a Scoutmaster, several Assistant Scoutmasters, and about 50 other members. We also have adults in the roles of Quartermaster, Recording Secretary, and Treasurer. Committee members are encouraged to pursue Scouter training throughout their tenure with the Troop

### TROOP MEETING INFORMATION

Troop meetings take place church on Tuesdays from 6:30-8:30. The majority of Troop meetings are planned around rank advancement and merit badges. However, the Scouts also plan many activities, such as bowling or swimming, where the goal for the boys is just to have fun with their peers. Troop 767 holds a Court of Honor ceremony every three months in lieu of a Troop meeting.

As you and your son make the decision about which Troop he will join, Troop 767 invites you to join us at a Troop meeting and/or a Court of Honor to allow us to introduce our program.
